## FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



The “**Anointing of the Sick**” is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived.”

Traditionally referred to as Extreme Unction or Last Rites, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick was previously most commonly administered to the dying, for the remission of sins and the provision of spiritual strength and health. In modern times, however, its use has been expanded to all who are gravely ill or are about to undergo a serious operation, and the Church stresses a secondary effect of the sacrament: to help a person recover his health. Like Confession and Holy Communion, to which it is closely linked, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick can be repeated as often as is necessary.

With only one resident priest serving the entire 900 square miles that makes up St Brendan the Navigator Parish as hard as he tries Father Mark cannot be available all the time. So please let us know if you know of anyone in the hospital, homebound, sick or upcoming surgery. Call Kathleen in the parish office at 236-4785 or toll free 1-877-236-4785 or in the case of an emergency call the same number then extension 108 and leave a message. Father will respond as soon as he is available.

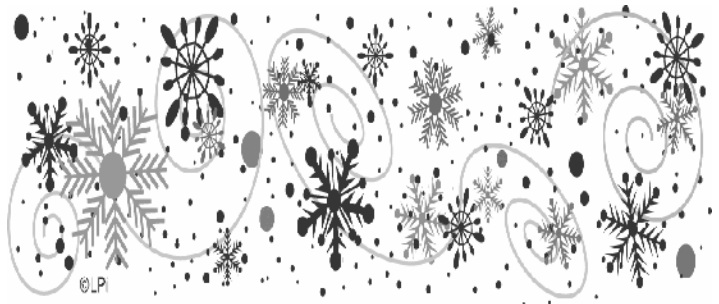

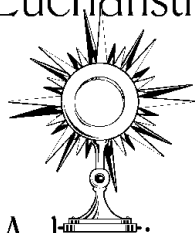
**Parish Snow Policy for Weekday Masses and Eucharistic Services:** *If there is no school or a school delay there is **NO** Mass or service.*

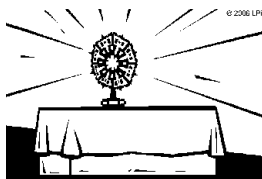
